Down syndrome (DS) is one of the commonest disorders with huge medical and social cost DS is associated with number of phenotypes including congenital heart defects, leukemia, Alzheimer’s disease, Hirschsprung disease etc DS individuals are affected by these phenotypes to a variable extent thus understanding the cause of this variation is a key

Down syndrome as a chromosomal anomaly Instead of the usual 46 chromosomes present in each cell, Lejeune observed 47 in the cells of individuals with Down syndrome It was later determined that an extra partial or complete chromosome 21 results in the characteristics associated with Down syndrome In ...
